





ACCOMMODATION



As Lisbon became a very attractive city, the accommodation for students has decreased and became more expensive. It is extremely important for students to start checking accommodation as soon as possible **before** the arrival.

We strongly advise to apply directly - and as soon as admitted - to the residences and private housing connections shown below: check the website, have an overview of all available accommodations (including location, specifications, rent and photos).



students are strongly discouraged to check for a room after arrival, as it will be extremely difficult to find accommodation within the city and there is a risk of not finding it at all!

Students with Disabilities

Students with disabilities may require additional facilities. These might include modifications to the house and/or other requirements such as the location of the apartment or size of the room.

If you need additional facilities in your living environment, please send an email detailing your requirements to the International Relations Office (IRO).

Finding suitable accommodation may take some time so please notify IRO as early as possible.



while searching for housing

Price range for a room from 350€ to 650€

Ask for what is included in the price
(It can be all-inclusive monthly rent or monthly rent excluding expenses - with sensible use, 30€ per person should suffice for utilities).

Ask if there is also bed linen, towels, cleaning service for the common area (monthly / weekly).

If your budget is tight, we advise you to share a room with another international student. A shared room is typically around 250€ per person.

If the bank account is not Portuguese, and the room is in Lisbon - it is rarely legit!

Do not make a bank transfer without verifying the identity of the receiver.

ISCTE UNIVERSITY RESIDENCE

The Iscte Prof. José Pinto Peixoto University Residence is located off-campus and offers a very limited number of rooms. It meets some of the accommodation needs of its visiting students and teachers.
